

## Camp Nurse, Summer 2020



**DESCRIPTION:** Camp Onas seeks a licensed nurse to manage the Health Center for the 2020 Summer season. Camp Onas is a co-ed, overnight camp for children 7-14, with staff ages 16-21 for a total population of 210.

**EXPECTATIONS:** The Camp Nurse will provide basic medical care, dispense over the counter and prescription medication, and provide basic triage and simple diagnosis of injuries/medical problems. Nurses must document all medical care information. The Camp Nurse reports directly to the Camp Director.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Licensed as a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse.
- Must complete employee background screening process.
- Experience with children and young adults.
- Maintain current CPR and First Aid certification.
- Desire to work in a camp community.
- New-to-practice nurses also considered.

### **SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Ensure each camper has a health form on file. Review camper forms before camp as needed.
- Dispense medications as prescribed by camper's physician and as detailed on the health form.
- Prepare accident/incident reports for all accidents/incidents.
- Follow appropriate medical procedures, including record-keeping in the daily medical log and medication administration records, and managing and safeguarding medications and utilizing approved standing orders.
- Assist with onsite training for staff as needed.
- Meet with Camp Director daily to review any camper issues and specific areas of need that may arise.
- Administer over the counter medications as directed.
- Assess campers and staff who are ill or injured and determine if further medical attention is needed.
- Assist in stabilizing campers and staff requiring transportation to the hospital.
- Documentation of all injuries and care rendered. Nurses must document all over the counter medicines, first aid treatment, and communication with parents regarding camper health.
- Monitor/evaluate camp procedures, facilities, and conditions and suggest modifications that would create more healthful conditions at the camp.
- Other duties assigned by the Camp Director.

### **ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Maintain inventory of medical supplies.
- Keep Health Center clean and organized.
- Ability to communicate and work with campers, staff, and other healthcare professionals of various skill levels, and provide necessary instruction regarding medical care.

### **REQUIRED SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:**

- Flexible – able to go with the flow in a camp environment.
- Responsible and hardworking.
- Excellent bedside manner with children, friendly and personable.
- Strong assessment abilities.
- Team player.

**WORKING CONDITIONS:**

- The primary working area will be the Health Center.
- Camp Nurse have private quarters in the building that houses the Health Center and Office. This room includes a private bath/shower, A/C, and wireless internet as well as a small fridge. Meals and snacks included.
