

Medication Packaging:

All medication must arrive in pharmacy-prepared or original packaging.

If multiple pills are to be taken at one time, they will need to be packaged in individual pill packs. Many pharmacies do this at a minimal charge, or look on-line at sites like Dispill or PackMyRx. For ease of use, we suggest contacting HorshamRx.com. We have been working with them for years.

Horsham Pharmacy: (www.horshamrx.com)

- Local, affordable, and independently owned and operated.
- Delivers medications directly to camp.
- They have printable prescription sheets available.
- Charge \$1/week to package the medications in blister packs, and they accept most insurance plans.
- They sell and package “over the counter” medications at the store price that your camper may take to be packaged together.
- **They will need your prescription by June 1st and they will deliver your camper’s packs directly to Onas.**

OR:

Your own Pharmacy or on-line resources:

- Some national pharmacies will individually package upon request.
- Most pharmacies will package both prescribed and “over-the-counter” medications together, provided you have a prescription for all of the requested medications.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

- Self-packaged medications in any container.
- This includes Day-of-the-week organizers, ‘cold-sealed’ packaging from Amazon, or ziplocks.

WHAT ABOUT...?

Non-pill medications:

- inhalers, liquids, injections, and creams must be in their original packaging with pharmacy label attached.
- Must be labeled for the individual camper and have the accompanying Medication Order Form.
- Not expired!
